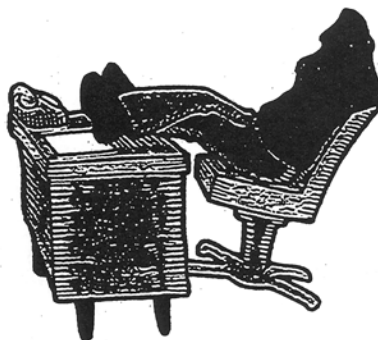

## **The need for this program**

The traditional method of teaching touch-typing is tedious to learn and slow in yielding results, generally requiring about a year of formal classroom instruction and hours of boring drills. And many people find that the computer-based touch-typing programs they've tried are no improvement. These flashy programs are full of timed gimmicks for speed tests, but they don't teach you how to find the letterers as fast as possible in the first place.

Most people today are too busy to take a year off to learn how to touch-type — so they just hunt and peck. The hunt and peck approach, however, requires a constant movement of the head back and forth for visual relocation between the page, the screen and the keyboard. Valuable mini-seconds and energy are lost between each letter typed. This frequent occurrence adds up to scores of hours lost in production time and efficiency. With the hunt and peck system, there is simply no way to increase typing speed past a certain point.

Today's computer-saturated marketplace is faced with a desperate need for speedy, accurate typists. We are limping to meet the need with a tediously slow methodology that reaches far too few of us, far too late. Computer keyboards are the pencils of the future, and fast keyboarding is the skill of the future!

## **How Zoom-Type works – and *why* it works**

We can shift the process of learning touch-typing into hyper-drive by taking hundreds of mental pictures of the keyboard while letters appear and disappear. These visual snapshots are typed five times a day for five-minute sessions for five days. This develops keyboard memory.

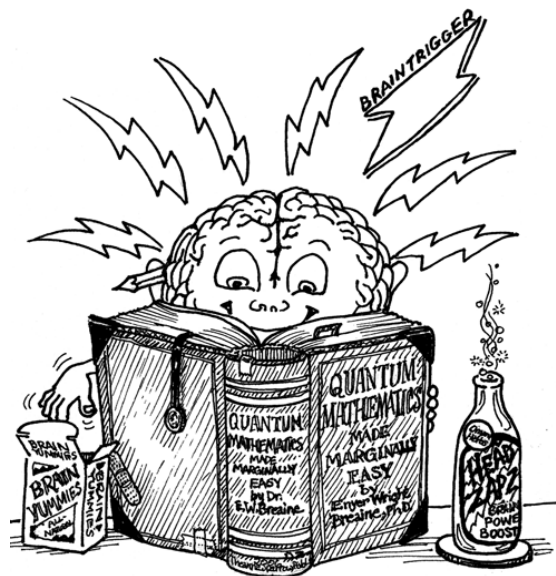
In contrast to old approaches, where letters are acquired slowly over time, Zoom-Type teaches the entire keyboard quickly, and then continues to imprint letter locations within that total picture. In addition, the fingers are taught exactly what to do by doing keyboard finger calisthenics to music. Put the two together and presto! You can learn to touch-type *in just five days*. From then on, it's just a matter of increasing your speed.
